Summary Comments:

The Department PRT Team reviewing Martin Dominguez for tenure has evaluated Mr. Dominguez in accordance with the established College Procedures and Timelines for Reappointment and Tenure, addressing all four evaluation criteria. For this evaluation the team considered the following:

A portfolio presented by the candidate including:

- A self-evaluation statement
- A vision statement
- An annotated list of contributions to the department, college, and students
- Examples of class syllabi, assignments, exams, and quizzes
- Other course-related materials
- Evidence of professional development
- Written evaluations based on classroom observations by each team member
- A completed Departmental Promotion, Retention, and Tenure Committee Evaluation Form

We found that Mr. Dominguez has exhibited strong performance in each area noted above as detailed in the annotations to the departmental evaluation form. The care and effort he applies to the preparation of his courses coupled with his teaching ability results in a solid performance in the classroom. In addition, Mr. Dominguez has done much in the way of service to his students beyond the classroom and to the College in general. He regularly attends Admissions events and mentors solo exhibitions in the Harriman Student Gallery. He has served on college-wide and departmental committees, and has demonstrated commitment to professional development through graduate-level coursework.




